Challenge Rules

- The Challenge is open to all students aged 11-14 years old from secondary schools in London.
- The Challenge registration form must be completed by a nominated teacher. Only one registration per school is required, but registrations from individual teachers for specific classes are welcome.
- There is no limit to the number of participants per school.
- The nominated teacher will be sent a school ID reference code to the email address provided. The reference code is needed for students to access the Challenge Quiz. It is the teacher's responsibility to provide students with the code.
- Students will also be required to create their own user name to take part in the Challenge Quiz. The user name, together with the school ID reference code, will be used to identify students in the draw for the Grand Final.
- Students should keep a record of their user name. Teachers are also advised to keep a record of all their students' user names. If a student forgets their user name they will need to create a new one and start the quiz again.
- Students must complete all three sections of the Challenge Quiz to be eligible for the Grand Final draw.
- Registered teachers will be notified via email and/or phone if their students have been selected for the Grand Final.
- The closing date for registration and completion of the Challenge Quiz is specified on the relevant web pages.
- Only students taking part in the Grand Final at City Hall will be eligible for prizes.
- The London Hydrogen Partnership may ask the winners to take part in promotional activity arising from the Challenge.
- Entry into this Challenge implies acceptance of these rules.
